



The relative strengths and weaknesses of Apache Offshore Investment Partnership are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Apache Offshore Investment Partnership compared to the market average is the variable Long-term Debt, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 40% points. The greatest weakness of Apache Offshore Investment Partnership is the variable Other Revenues, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 14% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 187%, being 116% points above the market average of 70%.
