



The relative strengths and weaknesses of Karuna Therapeutics Inc. are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Karuna Therapeutics Inc. compared to the market average is the variable Assets, Current, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 55% points. The greatest weakness of Karuna Therapeutics Inc. is the variable Research and Development, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 12% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 260%, being 182% points above the market average of 78%.
