



The relative strengths and weaknesses of Terns Pharmaceuticals Inc. are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Terns Pharmaceuticals Inc. compared to the market average is the variable Assets, Current, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 70% points. The greatest weakness of Terns Pharmaceuticals Inc. is the variable Other Revenues, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 15% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 256%, being 178% points above the market average of 78%.
