


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
TEXAS INSTRUMENTS

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The relative strengths and weaknesses of Texas Instruments INC are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Texas Instruments INC compared to the market average is the variable Net Income, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 79% points. The greatest weakness of Texas Instruments INC is the variable Liabilities, Non-Current, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 78% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 225%, being 50% points above the market average of 175%.
