







The relative strengths and weaknesses of Fairchild Semiconductor International INC are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Fairchild Semiconductor International INC compared to the market average is the variable Liabilities, Current, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 57% points. The greatest weakness of Fairchild Semiconductor International INC is the variable Other Expenses, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 82% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 239%, being 75% points above the market average of 165%.
