











The relative strengths and weaknesses of FEDEX CORP are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of FEDEX CORP compared to the market average is the variable Revenues, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 188% points. The greatest weakness of FEDEX CORP is the variable Operating Expenses, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 132% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 200%, being 52% points above the market average of 148%.
