

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The relative strengths and weaknesses of GRANT PARK FUTURES FUND LIMITED PARTNERSHIP are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of GRANT PARK FUTURES FUND LIMITED PARTNERSHIP compared to the market average is the variable Other Net Income, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 39% points. The greatest weakness of GRANT PARK FUTURES FUND LIMITED PARTNERSHIP is the variable Revenues, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 34% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 210%, being 54% points above the market average of 156%.
