

The relative strengths and weaknesses of DIVERSIFIED 2000 FUTURES FUND L.P. are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of DIVERSIFIED 2000 FUTURES FUND L.P. compared to the market average is the variable Other Assets, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 88% points. The greatest weakness of DIVERSIFIED 2000 FUTURES FUND L.P. is the variable Net Income, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 131% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 80%, being 76% points below the market average of 156%.
