The greatest strength of BlackRock Inc. compared to the market average is the variable Expenses, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 22% points. The greatest weakness of BlackRock Inc. is the variable Long-term Liabilities, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 136% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 22%, being 134% points below the market average of 156%.
