


The relative strengths and weaknesses of United States Commodity Index Funds Trust are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of United States Commodity Index Funds Trust compared to the market average is the variable Assets, Current, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 103% points. The greatest weakness of United States Commodity Index Funds Trust is the variable Revenues, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 36% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 196%, being 40% points above the market average of 156%.
