



The relative strengths and weaknesses of Interactive Brokers Group Inc. are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Interactive Brokers Group Inc. compared to the market average is the variable Financial Securities, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 60% points. The greatest weakness of Interactive Brokers Group Inc. is the variable Payables, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 154% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 15%, being 140% points below the market average of 156%.
