



The relative strengths and weaknesses of Cboe Global Markets Inc. are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Cboe Global Markets Inc. compared to the market average is the variable Revenue from Contract with Customer, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 333% points. The greatest weakness of Cboe Global Markets Inc. is the variable Other Expenses, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 192% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 234%, being 109% points above the market average of 125%.
