The relative strengths and weaknesses of BlackRock Inc. are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of BlackRock Inc. compared to the market average is the variable Revenue from Contract with Customer, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 22% points. The greatest weakness of BlackRock Inc. is the variable Long-term Liabilities, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 130% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 40%, being 117% points below the market average of 157%.
