The relative strengths and weaknesses of Interactive Brokers Group Inc. are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Interactive Brokers Group Inc. compared to the market average is the variable Financial Securities, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 41% points. The greatest weakness of Interactive Brokers Group Inc. is the variable Payables, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 158% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 14%, being 143% points below the market average of 157%.
