

BlackRock Inc. Rank 57 of 74

The relative strengths and weaknesses of BlackRock Inc. are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of BlackRock Inc. compared to the market average is the variable Revenue from Contract with Customer, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 44% points. The greatest weakness of BlackRock Inc. is the variable Long-term Liabilities, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 134% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 50%, being 143% points below the market average of 193%.
