



The relative strengths and weaknesses of Tronox Holdings plc are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Tronox Holdings plc compared to the market average is the variable Net Income, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 94% points. The greatest weakness of Tronox Holdings plc is the variable Liabilities, Noncurrent, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 124% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 3.8%, being 116% points above the market average of -113%.
