

Palo Alto Networks Inc Rank 13 of 27

The relative strengths and weaknesses of Palo Alto Networks Inc are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Palo Alto Networks Inc compared to the market average is the variable Expenses, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 348% points. The greatest weakness of Palo Alto Networks Inc is the variable Revenues, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 296% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 202%, being 4.8% points above the market average of 197%.
