


COMPUTERS AND OFFICE EQUIPMENT 2020

Apple Inc. Rank 13 of 27







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The relative strengths and weaknesses of Apple Inc. are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Apple Inc. compared to the market average is the variable Administrative and Marketing Exp., increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 140% points. The greatest weakness of Apple Inc. is the variable Liabilities, Noncurrent, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 114% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 203%, being 2.2% points above the market average of 201%.
