



The relative strengths and weaknesses of GOLDFIELD CORP are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of GOLDFIELD CORP compared to the market average is the variable Liabilities, Non-Current, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 70% points. The greatest weakness of GOLDFIELD CORP is the variable Other Liabilities, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 97% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 213%, being 56% points above the market average of 157%.
