



The relative strengths and weaknesses of Reliant Holdings Inc. are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all var_labels having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Reliant Holdings Inc. compared to the market average is the variable Revenues, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 631% points. The greatest weakness of Reliant Holdings Inc. is the variable Expenses, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 216% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 487%, being 426% points above the market average of 61%.
