



The relative strengths and weaknesses of IES Holdings Inc. are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all var\_labels having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of IES Holdings Inc. compared to the market average is the variable Revenues, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 78% points. The greatest weakness of IES Holdings Inc. is the variable Expenses, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 222% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 176%, being 26% points below the market average of 202%.
