



The relative strengths and weaknesses of HPIL Holding are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of HPIL Holding compared to the market average is the variable General And Administrative Expense, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 161% points. The greatest weakness of HPIL Holding is the variable Net Income, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 1,377% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is -1,982%, being 1,815% points below the market average of -167%.
