





The relative strengths and weaknesses of Driven Deliveries Inc. are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Driven Deliveries Inc. compared to the market average is the variable Intangible Assets, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 131% points. The greatest weakness of Driven Deliveries Inc. is the variable Net Income, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 153% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is -169%, being 126% points below the market average of -43%.
