



The relative strengths and weaknesses of Whole Earth Brands Inc. are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Whole Earth Brands Inc. compared to the market average is the variable Intangible Assets, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 61% points. The greatest weakness of Whole Earth Brands Inc. is the variable Liabilities, Long Term, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 87% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 63%, being 6.4% points above the market average of 56%.
