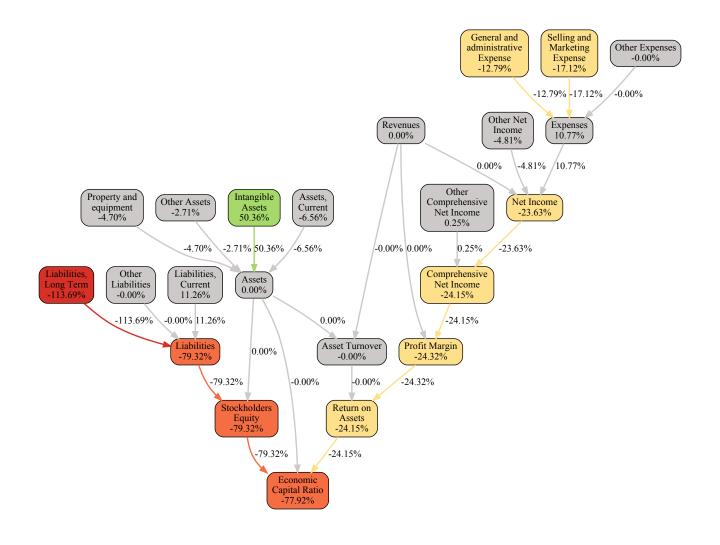

TreeHouse Foods Inc. Rank 22 of 27





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The relative strengths and weaknesses of TreeHouse Foods Inc. are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of TreeHouse Foods Inc. compared to the market average is the variable Intangible Assets, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 50% points. The greatest weakness of TreeHouse Foods Inc. is the variable Liabilities, Long Term, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 114% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 82%, being 78% points below the market average of 160%.
