

CHASE GENERAL CORP Rank 24 of 30

The relative strengths and weaknesses of CHASE GENERAL CORP are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of CHASE GENERAL CORP compared to the market average is the variable Revenues, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 431% points. The greatest weakness of CHASE GENERAL CORP is the variable Expenses, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 458% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 60%, being 34% points below the market average of 94%.
