

## Mondelez International Inc. Rank 17 of 40

The relative strengths and weaknesses of Mondelez International Inc. are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Mondelez International Inc. compared to the market average is the variable Expenses, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 126% points. The greatest weakness of Mondelez International Inc. is the variable Revenues, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 84% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 117%, being 8.7% points above the market average of 109%.
