


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The relative strengths and weaknesses of U.S. GOLD CORP. are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of U.S. GOLD CORP. compared to the market average is the variable Revenues, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 364% points. The greatest weakness of U.S. GOLD CORP. is the variable Cost of Revenue, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 476% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 21%, being 115% points above the market average of -94%.
