




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MINING 2018

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The relative strengths and weaknesses of ROYAL MINES & MINERALS CORP are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of ROYAL MINES & MINERALS CORP compared to the market average is the variable Liabilities, Non-Current, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 26% points. The greatest weakness of ROYAL MINES & MINERALS CORP is the variable Property, Plant and Equipment, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 97% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is -334%, being 240% points below the market average of -94%.
