



The relative strengths and weaknesses of Pershing Gold Corp. are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Pershing Gold Corp. compared to the market average is the variable Liabilities, Current, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 88% points. The greatest weakness of Pershing Gold Corp. is the variable Revenues, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 21% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 190%, being 284% points above the market average of -94%.
