



The relative strengths and weaknesses of ENERGY FUELS INC are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of ENERGY FUELS INC compared to the market average is the variable Liabilities, Current, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 75% points. The greatest weakness of ENERGY FUELS INC is the variable Cost of Revenue, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 4.6% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 140%, being 225% points above the market average of -85%.
