



The relative strengths and weaknesses of Summit Materials Inc. are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Summit Materials Inc. compared to the market average is the variable Liabilities, Current, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 71% points. The greatest weakness of Summit Materials Inc. is the variable Other Liabilities, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 90% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 59%, being 144% points above the market average of -85%.
