

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MOTOR VEHICLE PARTS 2018

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The relative strengths and weaknesses of LEAR CORP are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of LEAR CORP compared to the market average is the variable Net Income, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 414% points. The greatest weakness of LEAR CORP is the variable Other Expenses, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 380% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 196%, being 316% points above the market average of -121%.
