



The relative strengths and weaknesses of GENTEX CORP are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of GENTEX CORP compared to the market average is the variable Net Income, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 415% points. The greatest weakness of GENTEX CORP is the variable Cost of Goods and Services Sold, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 199% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 522%, being 520% points above the market average of 2.3%.
