



The relative strengths and weaknesses of Laredo Petroleum Inc. are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Laredo Petroleum Inc. compared to the market average is the variable Operating Expenses, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 97% points. The greatest weakness of Laredo Petroleum Inc. is the variable Other Assets, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 63% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is -86%, being 93% points above the market average of -180%.
