

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EP Energy Corp Rank 27 of 78



The relative strengths and weaknesses of EP Energy Corp are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of EP Energy Corp compared to the market average is the variable Net Income, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 114% points. The greatest weakness of EP Energy Corp is the variable Long-term Debt, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 107% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 9.8%, being 190% points above the market average of -180%.
