



The relative strengths and weaknesses of DEEP WELL OIL & GAS INC are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of DEEP WELL OIL & GAS INC compared to the market average is the variable Oil and Gas Property, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 115% points. The greatest weakness of DEEP WELL OIL & GAS INC is the variable Revenues, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 65% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 173%, being 305% points above the market average of -132%.
