



The relative strengths and weaknesses of EVOLUTION PETROLEUM CORP are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of EVOLUTION PETROLEUM CORP compared to the market average is the variable Net Income, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 187% points. The greatest weakness of EVOLUTION PETROLEUM CORP is the variable Operating Expenses, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 111% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 221%, being 352% points above the market average of -132%.
