





The relative strengths and weaknesses of RESERVE PETROLEUM CO are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of RESERVE PETROLEUM CO compared to the market average is the variable Revenue from Contract with Customer, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 133% points. The greatest weakness of RESERVE PETROLEUM CO is the variable Other Revenues, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 99% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 227%, being 233% points above the market average of -6.0%.
