



The relative strengths and weaknesses of CARRIZO OIL & GAS INC are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of CARRIZO OIL & GAS INC compared to the market average is the variable Other Revenues, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 151% points. The greatest weakness of CARRIZO OIL & GAS INC is the variable Long-term Debt, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 102% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 142%, being 148% points above the market average of -6.0%.
