



The relative strengths and weaknesses of MURPHY OIL CORP are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of MURPHY OIL CORP compared to the market average is the variable Net Income, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 155% points. The greatest weakness of MURPHY OIL CORP is the variable Other Revenues, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 84% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 157%, being 219% points above the market average of -62%.
