



The relative strengths and weaknesses of EVOLUTION PETROLEUM CORP are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of EVOLUTION PETROLEUM CORP compared to the market average is the variable Other Revenues, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 350% points. The greatest weakness of EVOLUTION PETROLEUM CORP is the variable Revenue from Contract with Customer, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 175% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 318%, being 380% points above the market average of -62%.
