



The relative strengths and weaknesses of DEVON ENERGY CORP DE are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of DEVON ENERGY CORP DE compared to the market average is the variable Operating Expenses, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 120% points. The greatest weakness of DEVON ENERGY CORP DE is the variable Cost of Goods and Services Sold, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 199% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 76%, being 138% points above the market average of -62%.
