



The relative strengths and weaknesses of NORTHERN OIL & GAS INC. are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of NORTHERN OIL & GAS INC. compared to the market average is the variable Other Revenues, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 153% points. The greatest weakness of NORTHERN OIL & GAS INC. is the variable Revenue from Contract with Customer, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 101% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 4.8%, being 67% points above the market average of -62%.
