



The relative strengths and weaknesses of CONTINENTAL RESOURCES INC are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of CONTINENTAL RESOURCES INC compared to the market average is the variable Revenue from Contract with Customer, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 168% points. The greatest weakness of CONTINENTAL RESOURCES INC is the variable Other Revenues, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 99% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 274%, being 221% points above the market average of 54%.
