



The relative strengths and weaknesses of EVOLUTION PETROLEUM CORP are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of EVOLUTION PETROLEUM CORP compared to the market average is the variable Other Expenses, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 258% points. The greatest weakness of EVOLUTION PETROLEUM CORP is the variable Operating Expenses, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 506% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is -99%, being 153% points below the market average of 54%.
