

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Extraction Oil & Gas Inc. Rank 65 of 104

The relative strengths and weaknesses of Extraction Oil & Gas Inc. are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all var_labels having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Extraction Oil & Gas Inc. compared to the market average is the variable Revenue from Contract with Customer, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 96% points. The greatest weakness of Extraction Oil & Gas Inc. is the variable Other Revenues, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 91% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 89%, being 27% points above the market average of 63%.
