

## CHESAPEAKE ENERGY CORP Rank 63 of 93

The relative strengths and weaknesses of CHESAPEAKE ENERGY CORP are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all var\_labels having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of CHESAPEAKE ENERGY CORP compared to the market average is the variable Other Revenues, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 202% points. The greatest weakness of CHESAPEAKE ENERGY CORP is the variable Other Expenses, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 151% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 23%, being 2.5% points below the market average of 26%.
