



The relative strengths and weaknesses of JUNIPER PHARMACEUTICALS INC are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of JUNIPER PHARMACEUTICALS INC compared to the market average is the variable Net Income, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 643% points. The greatest weakness of JUNIPER PHARMACEUTICALS INC is the variable Cost of Goods Sold, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 242% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 162%, being 579% points above the market average of -417%.
