



The relative strengths and weaknesses of Orgenesis Inc. are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Orgenesis Inc. compared to the market average is the variable Intangible Assets, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 190% points. The greatest weakness of Orgenesis Inc. is the variable Cost of Goods Sold, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 102% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is -91%, being 326% points above the market average of -417%.
